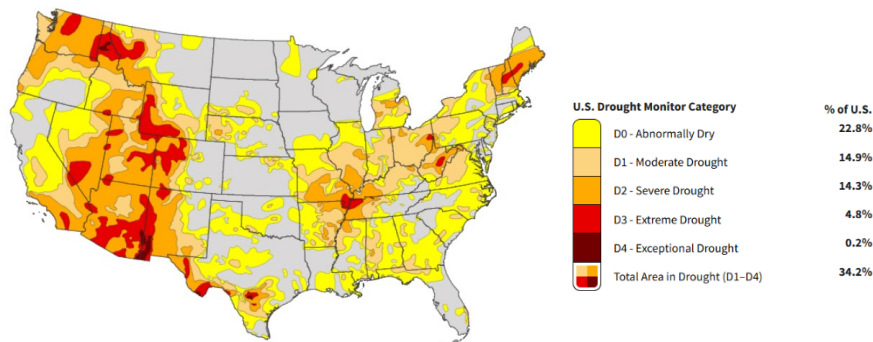


Prompt 1: Drought

- Did you notice drought conditions in your community?
- What impacts did you observe? (Examples: low streamflows, municipal water supply, household issue, wells, soils, habitat, fisheries, crops, water quality, etc.)
- Water conservation is a key imperative in the Mid-Coast Action Plan – did you see messaging and/or actions to reduce water use this past summer? Please describe.
- What role could the Mid-Coast Partnership take on to make the coast more resilient to drought and a changing climate?

Note: consider submitting an Observer Report on www.drought.gov to help illustrate how drought impacted the Oregon Coast.



Prompt 2: Role of the Partnership

- What should be the role of the Partnership in supporting the Water Action Plan implementation (project management/coordination, grant writing/financial coordination, project sharing and tracking, outreach and community engagement, etc.)?
- How do you see your organization engaging with the Partnership?
- In seeking funding for a Partnership coordinator, the Partnership must identify goals, objectives and a position description. List three primary responsibilities you would like to see the coordinator focus on over the next 2-4 years.
