Work Plan Objectives

- To provide a guide to assist with action implementation
 - To identify tasks that support implementation of actions

Work Plan Organization

- For each imperative, start with Group A actions then B then C
 - Imperatives are not competing; work plans will be developed for Group A actions for each imperative first
- For each Group, group similar actions as appropriate if implementation tasks will be similar
- Differentiate between Foundational actions (e.g., studies, analyses, reports) and Project-Based actions
- Identify tasks to support actions
 - For any known projects in development, and
 - For implementing actions that have no known projects or that could have more projects

Work Plan Example: Imperative 8

- Group A2: Protecting Water Instream
- Foundational Actions
 - Action 52: Limits on appropriation of water on high priority streams where water is not available for meeting aquatic life needs
 - Action 54: Determine ecological flows and identify basinwide in-stream demands...
- Existing initiatives to build on
- Associated performance metrics from Water Action Plan
- Identified projects information

Work Plan Example: Imperative 8

- Example project: Siletz Flow Restoration Analysis
 - Example tasks
 - Identify a project lead
 - Identify and apply for grants
 - Approach: Review grant databases and contact funding organizations, and apply for appropriate grants
 - Resources: Project partners
 - Work product: List of appropriate grants and timelines, grant applications
